



Coaches Code of Conduct

1. I will be a role model by setting a good example. I will be generous with your praise when it is deserved. Children need a coach that they can respect.
2. I will motivate children to do their very best and make each child feel that he or she has contributed something of value.
3. I will ensure that my players' baseball/softball experience is one of fun and enjoyment. Players should never be yelled at or ridiculed for making mistakes or losing a game. Winning is desirable but winning at any cost defeats the purpose of the game.
4. I will teach my players the rules of the game. I will prepare my practice sessions to meet realistic objectives.
5. During game, players must remain in the dugout area in an orderly fashion at all times.
6. I will respect the umpires' authority at all times. I will not verbally abuse or harass the umpire or enter the field of play without the umpire's permission. I should admonish player and spectator abuse of the umpire. Players on the sideline and spectators will be instructed by me never to enter the field of play during a game.
7. I should always exhibit proper behavior while interacting with players at practice or in a game. The use of foul or abusive language is prohibited.
8. I will not use alcohol or tobacco during practices or games.
9. After each game, each team must clean up trash in dugout and around stands.

Failure to comply with the above may result in expulsion from the field or complex.
