 - **Field Prep** – **THIS IS A PAID POSITION**. \$20.00 per field to grate and chalk the day of games. HAYAA has (drag, equipment to chalk, and template). Individuals interested would need to supply trailer and quad. Each field to prep takes approximately 20 minutes. HAYAA has a total of 14 fields. Possible options are to recruit the older umpires. Also, looking to quote some landscaping companies in the area. ** (Farms field prep not included in this position. Will still be prepared by volunteers from 2010).

2011 BUDGET:

- (9-11) Minors (Boys and Girls) Increase to player fees by \$5.00 (\$115.00).
 - New this season, Board members will only pay for uniform costs (\$40.00) for their own children playing for the 2011 Baseball/Softball season. This is a way to thank our members for their time and dedication to the HAYAA program.
 - Out of the equipment budget we will upgrade to new heavy duty equipment bags (one per coach/team). Included in field maintenance budget is the expense for adding bat/ball holders to each field dugout (22-26 dugouts total).
 - Flyers to be discussed at December meeting (ready to be distributed by January 2011). Registration form was also approved.
 - The dugouts for Winegarner (approved at the September meeting) have been constructed and Carla Wilson has agreed to paint.
 - Currently taking bids for lawn mowing. Please send any recommendations that may be interested in providing a bid to HAYAA.
