HAYAA FOOTBALL REGISTRATION DATES ANNOUNCED:

Hayaa Football Registration will be **Saturday, March 13th and 20th, 2010** at Ore Creek Middle School from **9a-3p**. Plan to bring a **copy** of your players Birth Certificate and a copy of your player's current year Report Card. A 2010 Physical form will need to be turned by the 1st day of practice. Physicals must be dated after April 15, 2010. **We are pleased to announce player fees have not been increased for the 2010 season!** On top of that good news, a **\$10 per player discount** will be available to those that wish to RE-USE their PRACTICE JERSEY. You MUST bring your practice jersey to Registration (to make sure it will fit over the pads your player will wear in the 2010 season) in order to obtain the \$10 discount. No exceptions. After much discussion and brain storming, the Hayaa Football Board has determined that because we were disappointed in the quality of Jersey last season combined with the sheer number of player number duplications (*we did the research-up to 15 # duplications on one of our 2010 teams-based on previous players moving up Example: two #15's, two #22's etc.*) we will be unable to offer the Game Jersey discount we had hoped to offer for the 2010 Season. *All paperwork must be received by March 31, 2010. Any registrations that come in from April 1 - May 31, 2010 will be wait listed and have the late fee of \$25.00 applied. After June 1, 2010 registration is closed.*

DEPOSIT FEE: We are always trying to seek ways to keep cost down. However, with equipment costs on the rise, it leaves us no choice. It costs up to \$400+ to outfit one football player. We condition the equipment prior to each season. Equipment that cannot be reconditioned is replaced to ensure the safety of our players. Therefore, we have been forced to increase our 2010 Equipment/Eagle Duty Deposit Fee. Each player will be required to leave a check for **\$200**. This check can be post dated to August 2010. This check WILL BE returned on Equipment Hand-In Day being held in October 2010, once your equipment has been returned and your Eagle Duty was reported served.

FORMS: **COPIES** of Physicals, Birth Certificates, Report Cards, Player & Parent Code of Conduct, LCAJFL Code of Conduct are all due on or before your player can participate at ANY practice. These forms can be turned in at Registration & Equipment Hand Out. This rule will be enforced; your Team Coordinator will be checking and double checking. Don't let your player watch practice from the sidelines! **Send COPIES, this information WILL NOT/CAN NOT be returned.**
