What to bring: Players should wear t-shirt, shorts, cleats or tennis shoes's and bring water to drink.

Players will receive fundamental instruction from the Hartland High School Football Staff and Players. Techniques taught at camp can be seen at every level of football competition. Many professional and collegiate teams utilize the same techniques players will learn at this Hayaa camp.

Instruction will include:

- Individual instruction on stance, start and footwork.
- Position specific techniques used at all levels of football.
- Step-by-step progression of all individual run blocks especially the "Zone Block."
- Step-by-step progression of 1-on-1 and zone pass-protection techniques.
- Develop an understanding of the total offensive picture. "Learn football, not just assignments."
- Team work - working as a unit
