GAME ON

After a great round of scrimmages last weekend, Hartland Football is ready to take on their opponents for Game 1. There are a few things parents and fans should know:

1. Admission fees to games range from \$4-\$5, most facilities do have a senior and a child rate.
Hartland Rates are as follows: Adult \$4, Senior \$3 (60 and over), Students \$3, & Children 5 and under are free.
2. ALL (Home & Visitors) Players & cheerleaders get in free on game day when in full uniform. Coaches & parents pay the admission fee. (Hartland Coaches get in free at our Home field only)
3. Concession stands are available at every game field.
4. Parents and fans are not allowed on the game field.
5. Directions to fields can be found at Hayaasports.com or LCAJFL.com
6. Show your Eagle Pride & wear your Hartland Spirit wear! *Don't have any??? Buy it at every HOME game!!!*
7. All players need to arrive 1 hour prior to game time.

"LITTLE" BIG HOUSE PARKING

The Fire Marshal in Hartland has reminded us that no parking is allowed against the curb on the east/west side of our parking lot at our Home Football Stadium. **The Fire Marshal will be ticketing cars** that park in this zone. This zone needs to be kept clear in case there is an emergency.

EAGLE DUTY/COMMUNITY SERVICE

You should receive your Eagle Duty schedule soon.

Things you should know:

1. Everyone pays the admission fee to enter the field on Game Day except players, cheerleaders, Hartland coaches and High School age students performing community service
2. If it is your week for Eagle Duty, you are still required to pay admission. (Sons & Daughters covering Eagle Duty for a parent –and NOT community service–are required to also pay admission).

3. Show up for duty 5 minutes early to learn your job from the person serving before you.
4. Share your job responsibilities (train the next person) with the person coming in after you.
5. If you are unable to show for a time already assigned to you, it is your responsibility to trade with someone and then inform your Team Coordinator. *If you do not show, your check will be cashed* but the worst part is another family from your team will be forced to fill your position and your Team Coordinator will have to scramble to find someone.
6. Football families will be placed either at the Gate, Merchandise Table or the Concession Area. Cheer/Pom families will be at the Cheer Merchandise Table, 50/50 raffle and Visitors stands clean up for each home game.
7. Your team will provide 3 Chain Gangers, 1 Announcer and 1-2 spotters for every HOME game. *These positions are over and above the facility Eagle Duty positions.*
8. 9am Home game TEAMS will report to the field at 7am for set-up. 7pm Home game TEAMS will stay for field clean-up.
9. Your Color Coordinator will be on hand from the Freshman through the Varsity games. Team Coordinators will be available during your game times.
10. High school age students are allowed to work you community service hours. Anyone younger is not - due to liability issues.
