The house games start the first week of May and run through the third week of June. Games are usually Monday – Friday. There may be some house games on Saturdays.

The travel games start in April and run through the third week of July. The travel games are at Spranger and Ore Creek. There are usually travel games on Saturday and Sunday.

HAYAA will provide the field drag, a walk behind field chalker, the batter's box template, paint for foul lines, a landscape rake, bases and plugs. The Field Prep person will need to provide an ATV or small pick-up truck to drag the fields.

The person who did the fields last season used a side by side ATV. He is willing to help with the transition and training of a new person.
